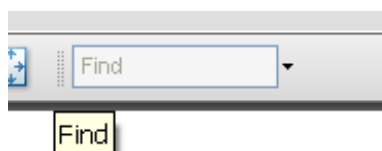

1. Searching for it.

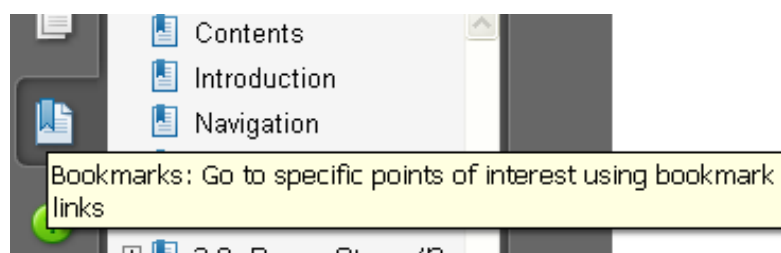
In your Adobe PDF Viewer everything is laid out easily for you to find. The [search box](#) is located at the top of the software and looks like this:

Finding MP3s on the Internet (especially good quality MP3s) is becoming a very hard task indeed.

It seems like everyone has got a website and everyone has their own MP3s . But their **quality** is wide ranging. So it takes you a huge amount of time to search, and if you have dial-up - along time to download.

Also how many sites “accidentally” place ads on your browser or computer. Or place a virus in the very depths of your computer once the music has been downloaded? Or even still have illegal MP3s on their site, you download them and get into trouble?

So I have created a **limited, hand picked directory** of sites that are worthy of your time and downloads.

They are split into the following categories:

- Radio Stations
- Labels
- Directories and
- Individual Artist sites.

To listen to (and use for your own personal hearing) the following **free programs** can be used, especially for Radio style sites
